Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to school and we hope you have had an enjoyable summer.

This term we will be learning about Time Travellers as our creative curriculum topic. A creative curriculum letter will be sent with this letter.

Just a couple of reminders:

Could you please send your child to school with a named drinks bottle, which they can re-fill throughout the day. Drinks bottles and snacks can be left on the shelf outside of the classroom. Your child will also need an 'art' shirt – this can be a large t-shirt or shirt that they can wear over their uniform for art and design lessons.

PE kit needs to be in school every day. Our PE sessions will be on a Monday and a Wednesday afternoon but sometimes this will need to change.

Can you please ensure that all of your child's equipment, clothing and PE kit is clearly named.

Spellings will be sent home every Monday and there will be a spelling test on a Friday.

Maths homework will be sent home on a Thursday to be returned on Tuesday please.

Reading books will be changed in class everyday, so please ensure that your child takes this opportunity. They may also choose a sharing book from our book corner, which they can change as often as they like. There will also be a visit to the school library weekly.

Reading at least three times a week with your child is beneficial for improving their fluency. We now have new reading records and sticker charts to encourage the children to read at least three times a week at home. Once they have read three times (or more) they will earn a sticker for their chart, which is kept in school. Once they have read 25, 50, 75 or 100 times they will receive a certificate.

If you have any questions or concerns please do not hesitate to catch us at the end of the day or by leaving a note in your child's reading record.
