

# Curriculum Overview for EYFS Autumn 2016 All About Me

## Communication Language and Literacy

- Listens to stories with increasing recall and attention
- Writing lists and labels- ascribes meaning to marks they draw and see.
- Literacy
- Recognising and writing our names
- Learning letters and sounds of the alphabet
- Looks at books independently.
- Listens to others
- Rhymes and action songs
- Responds to simple instructions
- Retell a simple past event in the correct order.
- Uses language through play- imagining and recreating roles

## Personal and Social Development

- Making friends, sharing and taking turns
- Learning the rules/routines of school and the classroom
- Personal hygiene (Washing hands before lunch etc.)
- Expressing likes and dislikes
- Knowing about ourselves and what we can do

## Expressive Arts and Design

- Drawing and painting pictures
- Experimenting with mixing colours
- Colour collage
- Printing using a range of materials
- Exploring beat and tempo by adding sounds to stories and rhymes.

## Mathematics

- Counting in order to 10  
Finding 1 more than (up to 5 objects)
- Naming and describing 2D and 3D shapes
- Talk about and recognise simple patterns
- Writing numerals to 10
- Compare length, and describe size
- Describe position

## Physical Development

- Becoming aware of space – playing collaborative games
- Gaining confidence and control with large and small equipment
- Handling tools correctly e.g. pencils, scissors, brushes etc. with increasing control.
- How do we feel after exercise?

## Understanding the world

- Find out about ourselves – our bodies, senses etc.
- Observe and record the weather and changing seasons
- Use computer programmes
- Explore sound and music
- Discuss and explore different celebrations - Bonfire night, Birthdays, Weddings, Diwali, Christmas
- What do you celebrate
