English Year 1

We will be learning how to write instructions, and use these instructions to make Christmas baubles. We will be recounting what the children did over the half term holiday and making this into a book, we will also look at writing recounts within our History. We will be looking at winter poetry and writing our own. We will be describing settings, making posters, and writing letters and postcards. The children will be looking at character profiles – Ernest Shackleton.

Year 1 Geography & History, EYFS Knowledge and Understanding of the world

In History the children will be looking at Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot in events beyond living memory. In Geography, the children will be looking at weather patterns and comparing and contrasting the Polar Regions with the UK. We will also be looking at the changes to the environment such as the melting of the Polar Ice Caps. We will be using world maps to locate the Arctic, Antarctic and British Isles.

We will look at Ernest Shackleton's expedition to Antarctica and plot his journey on a map.

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Science

Year 1

The children will be investigating seasonal changes, animal habitats, animal adaptation to the Polar climate and camouflage, Polar animal food chains, predator and prey relationships, properties of materials such as those that help keep us warm, and changing materials – exploring ice and water and investigating how to free a boat stick in ice

Understanding and Knowledge of the World EYFS –

The children will be going on seasonal walks to investigate the changes of the weather.

They will explore the changing of the weather and enjoy finding out what animals do in the Winter time

Year 1 Design & Technology, EYFS Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be learning about Andy Goldsworthy and his use of natural items to create art. They will also be creating large group collages of Arctic and Antarctic, and cold colour collages. For our Design & Technology, the children will be making a lever book – based on different types of weather, designing and making an ice palace, making card baubles, designing and making a new vehicle for Father Christmas to ride in.

Music

The children will be listening and responding to different styles of music, embedding the foundations of the interrelated dimensions of music, learning to sing and sing along with nursery rhymes and action songs, improvising leading to playing classroom instruments. They will be sharing and performing the learning that has taken place.

RE

The children will learn about different festivals and celebrations and discover the meanings behind them. Children will consider places of worship with the enquiry question of 'What makes places special?'.

DF

The children will be following Real PE and learning basic skills such as running, balancing and ball skills. PE is on a Tuesday and Thursday.
