### E-SAFETY



This term we have been teaching the children about e-safety, keeping safe when they are using a computer or a tablet or an I-phone and particularly when they go on the internet. We have stressed the importance of not giving out your name, address etc and not agreeing to meet anyone who may have contacted you. The message that what you write on the internet often goes to a wider audience, if not the whole world, is one that applies to adults as much as children. I am sending the SMART code that we have in school so that every family is aware that we treat this very seriously, and the latest newsletter about E-safety. I have also arranged some sessions for KS2 children with the Safer Schools Community Team (attached to the police) and a session for parents to which you are all invited. This will be on **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March** (the last week of this term) with the parents' session from **2.15 – 3.15 pm**. I arranged it at this time so that parents can come early for this input, before the usual pick-up time.

### NON-UNIFORM DAY

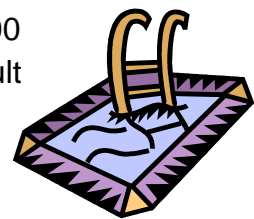
