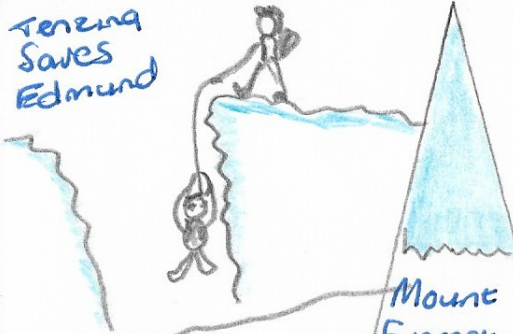


Part 2 - Mount EVEREST

Is the highest mountain on Earth.

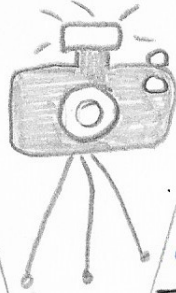
It's 8849mts above sea level.

Edmund Hillary and Tenzing Norgay reached the Summit on the 29th May 1953!

Over 200 people are known to have died on Mount Everest!

Empty oxygen Cylinders

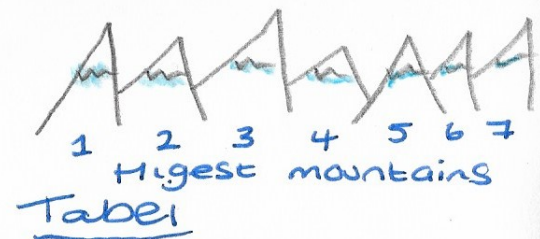
Food wrappers Broken tents Batteries.

Tenzing Norgay was born in Tibet 1914 one day's walk from Mount Everest!

One day while fixing rope handrails Edmund fell into a crevasse or (a huge crack in the mountain) it was Tenzing caught Edmund as he fell, he was able to pull him up. After that they worked together as a great climbing team!



was the first woman to climb Mount Everest in 2016! She was the first woman to conquer the "Seven Summits" the highest mountains on all seven continents
