Place value within 10 (Ext 20), which includes:

Counting forwards and backwards

Representing different numbers

Knowing one more and one less than a given number to 10 (Ext 20)

To begin to understand and use the $<=>$ symbol

Order and compare numbers

Writing numbers to 10 (Ext 20)

Addition and subtraction within 10

Look at ordinal numbers

EYFS –

Count objects actions and sounds

Learn to subitise (Show small quantities in familiar patterns (for example, dice) and random arrangements.

Counting to 10 forwards and backwards

Knowing the concept of numbers, comparing numbers

And matching amounts

Knowing number bonds to 5

Year 1 Geography & History, EYFS Knowledge and Understanding of the world

The children will be learning about the area they live in, the key features of maps and investigating why the area looks the way it does.

They will enjoy landmark hunts around the school field and enjoy using google earth to find where they live.

They will learn about the history of our school and local area

They will also enjoy the following provision activities:

Painting pictures of our grounds

Year 1 –

PSHE
