EYFS Maths

The children will learn about: Making pairs and combining groups Comparing mass and capacity Comparing numbers Circles and Triangles 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 0 3D shapes and patterns

Year 1 Maths

The children will learn about: Place Value within 20 and 50 Addition and Subtraction within 20 Length and Height Mass and Volume

Year 1 / EYFS English The children will learn about adventure stories, fiction stories, information texts, rhymes and poems with the support of a wide range of engaging fiction and non-fiction stories.

Year 1 History

The children will learn the history of London, including the Great Fire of London.

Year 1 Art

The children will learn about collagraph printing, including how to develop a motif to make single and repeated prints.

Year 1 D&T

The children will learn about wheels, axles and chassis and how they work together to make a vehicle move.

Year 1 Geography

The children will learn about the UK's bustling capital city. This will develop the children's knowledge of key locations, transport, the Royal Family, contrasting places and events that have shaped London's past.

Year 1 Science

The children will learn about the seasons, seasonal changes and typical seasonal weather and events. They will learn about measuring the weather and the role of a meteorologist. Children begin to learn about the science of day and night and recognise that the seasons have varying day lengths in the UK.

Hazel Class

Year 1 / EYFS RE

The children will learn about Purim, the lively festival that commemorates the strength of the Jewish people. The children will learn about synagogues and listen to the story of Queen Esther.

Year 1 / EYFS PSHE

The children will be learning to set simple goals and work out how to achieve them. They will be learning how to work well with a partner and how a challenge might stretch their learning. They will then learn to identify obstacles to achieving their goal and how to celebrate their achievements.

EYFS Expressive Art and Design The children will be working together to build structures using various resources and construction kits. They will look at existing products to inspire their ideas. The children will use a range of resources to create artwork of their faces. They will be introduced to painting and drawing techniques.

EYFS Understanding the World

Understanding the world Children will be using Handa's Surprise to explore a different country. Children will be listening to stories and placing events in chronological order. We will be asking important questions such as - What can we do here to take care of animals in the jungle? The children will be comparing animals from a jungle to those on a farm; learning their names and labelling their body parts. We will be investigating nocturnal animals and how they make sense of different environments and habitats. Using images, video clips, shared texts and other resources we will bring the wider world into the classroom. The children will be talking about what animals they have seen and will be learning to describe and comment on things they have seen whilst outside, including plants and animals. After close observation, the children will learn to draw pictures of the natural world, including animals and plants.

As part of our Amazing Animals theme, we will be looking at Rousseau's Tiger, recreating animal prints and designing homes for hibernating animals. We will be building upon our art skills by creating collage owls and symmetrical butterflies. Children will be encouraged to select the tools and techniques they need to assemble materials that they are using e.g creating animal masks. As part of Chinese New Year, the children will be making lanterns, practising their Chinese writing, puppet making, listening to Chinese music and composing their own music. The children will be putting on their own shadow puppet theatre. The children will be exploring different techniques for joining materials, such as how to use adhesive tape and different sorts of glue. Our artist study will be Yves Klein, with the children creating some

fabulous artworks in blue. We will also be investigating artists who use hearts in their work.
