

Year 2 Maths

This half term the children will learn about money and starting to investigate multiplication and division.

For money, the children will be looking pence and pounds as well as starting to compare amounts of money.

For multiplication and division, the children will learn how to use arrays to support their learning as well as making equal groupings.

Year 2 PSHE

This half term the children will focus on 'Dreams and Goals' where they will look at what they would like to succeed in and how they might achieve these. Children will also look at how they could learn from others' successes.

Year 2 RE

The children will learn about the Tibetan Buddhist New Year holiday, Losar, starts on the first day of the first month of the Tibetan calendar, which is usually in February. Year 2 English
