Year 1 / EYFS RE

The children will learn about the Naam Karan, a Sikh baby naming ceremony. Many Sikh parents bring their newborns to the Gurdwara (the Sikh temple) as soon as they are able to visit. The Granthi (reader of the scriptures) opens the holy book, the Guru Granth Sahib, at random, and the first letter of the first word on the left-hand page will be the first letter of the baby's name. After the Naam Karan, many Sikh children will continue to learn about the Sikh faith at home and at the Gurdwara.

Year 1 Science

The children will learn about children about wild and garden plants by exploring the local environment. They will identify and describe the basic parts of plants and observe how they change over time.

Year 1 / EYFS PSHE

The children will be learning about relationships, how to make friends, how to solve problems within friendships and know what makes a good friendship. They will learn about people who help us, how to ask for help, and how to help themselves and others when they feel upset or hurt.

Year 1 / EYFS English

The children will learn about stories, travel journals, traditional tales and adventure stories with the support of a wide range of engaging fiction and non-fiction stories.

Year 1 Art

The children will learn about artwork depicting streets and buildings and focuses on the work of the American pop artist, James Rizzi. They will create a 3-D mural based on Rizzi's work.

Year 1 D&T

The children will learn about sources of food and the preparatory skills of peeling, tearing, slicing, chopping, mashing and grating. They will use this knowledge and techniques to design and make a supermarket sandwich according to specific design criteria.

EYFS Expressive Art and Design

The children will be looking at Rousseau's Tiger and animal prints. Together, they will be designing homes for hibernating animals. They will be creating collage owls and symmetrical butterflies. The children will be encouraged to select the tools and techniques they need to assemble materials that they are using e.g creating animal masks.

Year 1 History

The children will learn about their own school and locality, both today and in the past. They compare schooling in the Victorian era to their experiences today.

EYFS Understanding the World

The children will be listening to stories and placing events in chronological order. They will be answering the question 'What can we do here to take care of animals in the jungle?'. The children will be comparing animals from a jungle to those on a farm, whilst exploring a range of jungle animals, including learning their names and labelling their body parts. The children will be investigating and learning about nocturnal animals, and making sense of different environments and habitats. We will be using images, video clips, shared texts and other resources to bring the wider world into the classroom. The children will be talking about what they see, and describing and commenting on things they have seen whilst outside, including plants and animals. After close observation, the children will be drawing pictures of the natural world, including animals and plants. The children will be introduced to significant figures who have been to space and begin to understand that these events happened before they were born.
